Mr. Kaser stated that there are other ways for them to distribute the bibles such as through PTA or through non-profit organizations that focus on activities for the students. Ms. Harris asked the Board if they had thought about making a policy that would allow the Gideon's to continue distributing the bibles. Mr. Barnabei stated that the Board will not violate the law.
