## RtI is not . . .

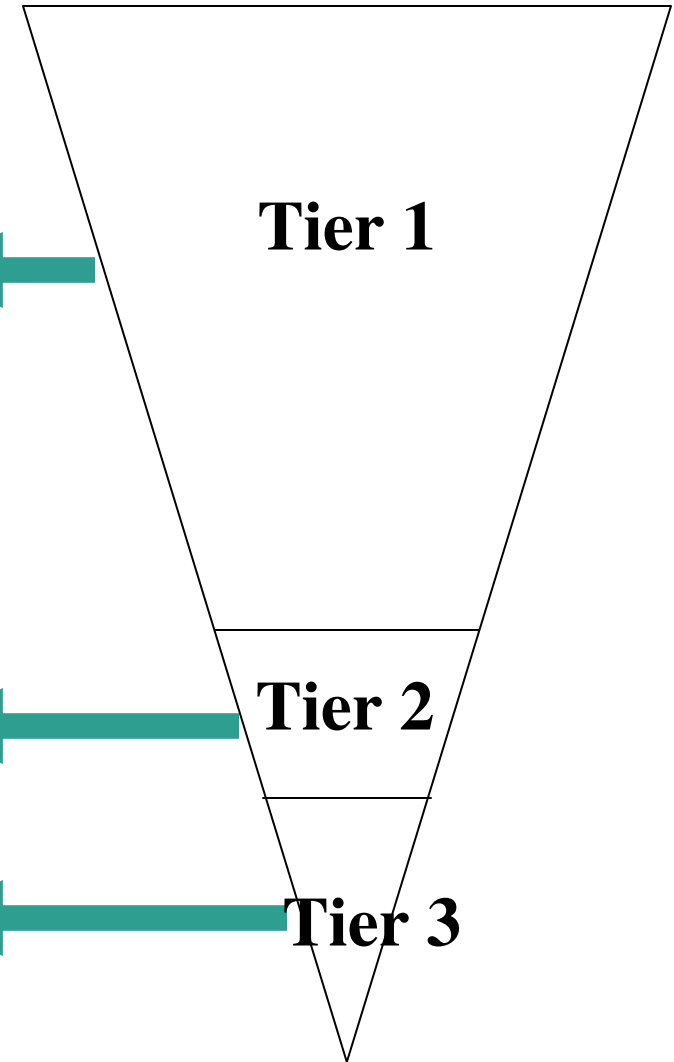
- Special Education

# Response to Intervention

90 minutes daily of reading instruction for ALL students in the general education classroom

Tier 1 plus 30 additional minutes of reading instruction for students who are performing below mastery. These students will receive 120 total minutes of reading instruction daily.

Tier 1 plus 60 additional minutes of reading instruction for students who continue to perform below mastery following the additional instructional time they received in Tier 2.
